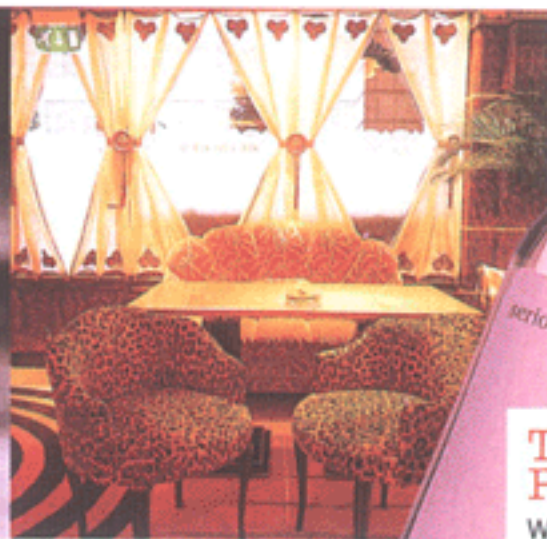

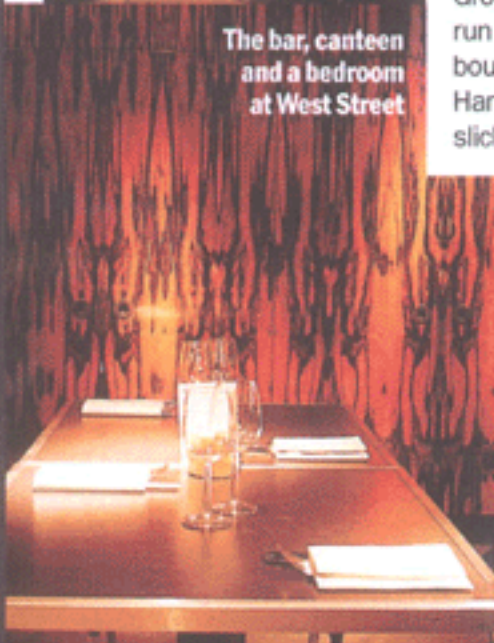

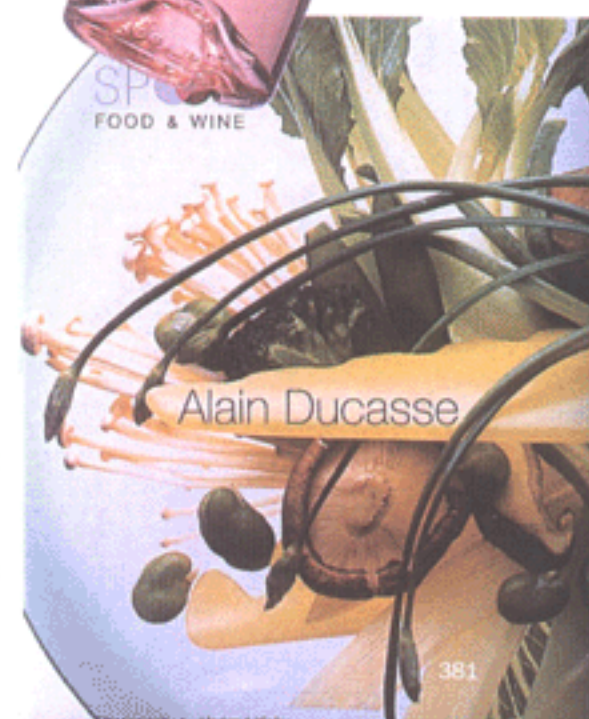
reason to stay
